Camerata RCO:

# Top Dutch ensemble to perform at Andermatt Music

Saturday 4 June 2022, 7.30 pm

Andermatt concertgoers are in for a royal treat on Whit Weekend: the Camerata RCO, founded by members of the renowned Royal Concertgebouw Orchestra, are performing in Switzerland's highest-lying concert hall. The ten-member ensemble will perform two great chamber works by Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart and Anton Bruckner.

Critics have hailed the Amsterdam-based Royal Concertgebouw Orchestra as the best in the world — and Queen Máxima of the Netherlands is its patroness. The Camerata RCO is made up of members of the Royal Concertgebouw Orchestra who enjoy expanding their musical activity by playing together in the smaller, more intimate chamber group. The ensemble appears in over 50 concerts annually in the world's major music capitals from New York to Tokyo. On 4 June, the Camerata RCO is leaving the big city to appear at Andermatt Music in the only concert hall in the Swiss Alps. The programme features two chamber works by Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart and Anton Bruckner.

The Clarinet Quintet in A major was written by the 33-year-old Mozart for his friend Anton Stadler, a Viennese clarinettist. With this quintet, Mozart created a new genre just two years before his death. In contrast, the evening's second work, Anton Bruckner's Symphony No. 7, was written when the composer was 61 – and only then marked his real breakthrough. In Andermatt, the ten-member Camerata RCO performs the 7th Symphony in a 1921 arrangement for chamber ensemble, demonstrating magnificently that a Bruckner symphony doesn't need a 100-piece orchestra.
